

## INTERNAL CALL FOR MOBILITY FELLOWSHIPS ERASMUS+ KA220-HED COMMUNIKITE PROJECT

TECHNICAL AND ACADEMIC TRAINING COURSES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF POITIERS.

Warsaw, 20 September 2024

Two international mobility grants of the Erasmus+ COMMUNIKITE Project (2023-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000153956) are available for training courses at the University of Poitiers for teaching and research staff.

The training visits will take place from 3rd – 5th December 2024 in accordance with the program established by the aforementioned institution on the theme "Cultural and linguistic mediation". The program will be aimed at the training of teaching staff and/or researchers in the field of foreign language teaching.

The following are the requirements to be able to apply for these grants:

- To be a member of the teaching (including adjunct) and research (including doctoral students) body at University of Warsaw at the time of implementation of the mobility.
- To have a theoretical and practical command of the language in which the training course will be conducted (English).

Priority will be given to members of the COMMUNIKITE project, junior teachers and to those persons who are currently being trained and have a research profile in foreign language teaching and learning considering the following criteria:

- Curricular evaluation (up to 3 points)
- Research profile in foreign language didactics specially aimed to migrants (up to 4 points)
- Membership of/having worked for the COMMUNIKITE project (up to 3 points).

Those wishing to participate in this call must submit their update curriculum vitae and a motivation letter and signed GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) consent statement ("Information on personal data processing", attached below) before 14 October 2024 at 12:00 noon to the email address <u>k.szymankiewicz@uw.edu.pl</u>.

This call will be decided by resolution of the COMMUNIKITE Project manager at the University of Warsaw. The decision will be made public on 31 October 2024 on the website of the Faculty of Modern Languages and the result will be notified by email to those interested and to all the Project coordinators. ## Information on personal data processing

## Controller

Data Protection Officer (DPO)

Controller has designated Data Protection Officer whom you may contact via email at iod@adm.uw.edu.pl. You may contact the DPO in all matters relating to your personal data processing by the University of Warsaw and the exercise of rights in relation to the processing of personal data.

The DPO, however, does not proceed other matters, like handling recruitment procedures, collecting recruitment documents, providing information on current recruitment process.

Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

Personal data of candidates for employment shall be processed for recruitment purposes only.

Your personal data shall be processed in the scope as indicated by employment law<sup>1</sup> (given name (names) and family name, date of birth, contact information as provided, education, professional qualifications, previous employment) for the purposes of this recruitment process<sup>2</sup>, whereas other data<sup>3</sup> shall be processed based on your consent which may take the following wording:

I agree to the processing of personal data provided in (e.g. CV, cover letter, and other submitted documents) by the University of Warsaw for realising my recruitment process.
